

FAQ

Q: Do I have to be there at 10 am?

A: No. Start times will be staggered. You can start any time between 10 am and 1 pm.

Q: How long does it take to walk?

A: At average walking pace, the course takes approximately 50 minutes to complete.

Q: Do I have to walk the full course?

A: No. There will be a hayride to shuttle walkers back from the finish. Just wave to the driver to get a ride.

Q: Where does the money go?

A: All funds raised will go toward projects and grants for our public schools. All donations are fully tax deductible.

Q: Will food be provided?

A: There will be water/snack stations along the walk route. In addition, the SW Historical Society is sponsoring their annual Heritage Day at the intersection of Main Street and Ferry Lane. Food will be available for purchase.
